Indications of a Leak

- The pooling of liquid on the ground
- An odor like petroleum liquids or gasoline
- A sheen on the surface of water
- An area of dead vegetation

Hazards of a Release

- Highly flammable and easily ignited by heat or sparks
- Vapors can be heavier than air and collect in low areas
- Contact with skin may cause burns, injury, or frostbite
- Fire may produce irritating and/or toxic gases
- Runoff may cause pollution
- Vapors may form an explosive mixture with air

Emergency Response

- Leave the area immediately, move upwind and warn others to stay away
- Keep possible ignition sources (starting an engine, lighting a match, using a cell phone) away from the area
