Indications of a Leak

The pooling of liquid on the ground

An odor like petroleum liquids or gasoline

A sheen on the surface of water

An area of dead vegetation

Hazards of a Release

Highly flammable and easily ignited by heat or sparks

Vapors can be heavier than air and collect in low areas

Contact with skin may cause burns, injury, or frostbite

Fire may produce irritating and/or toxic gases

Runoff may cause pollution

Vapors may form an explosive mixture with air

Emergency Response

Leave the area immediately, move upwind and warn others to stay away

Keep possible ignition sources (starting an engine, lighting a match, using a cell phone) away from the area
